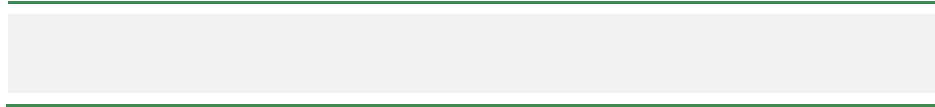


New Year's Eve Ball Drop
